

AIRBNB CLEANING CHECKLIST

THE BEDROOM

The bedroom lays the tone for a pleasant experience. Fortunately, it's also the most manageable place to clean.

- Make sure to strip used fabric, bed linen, blankets, wash linen, and towels.
- Vacuum carpets and rugs and mop the floors. Do your best to clean under the bed.
- Lint the guests' pillows and tidy up the sheets properly
- You can also hire cleaners to do professional bed making and deep cleaning of the bed.

THE BATHROOM

As an Airbnb owner, it is essential to make sure that the bathroom is clean. A clean bathroom is the first thing your guest will be looking for.

- Ensure you give the bathroom and bathtub a deep clean before the guest's check-in and after every checkout.
- Do not enable grime to develop or allow water stains on the bathroom doors and mirrors.
- Use toilet cleaners, mops, buckets, and wipes.
- Keep tabs on toiletries and supplies, replace all items at any signs of wear.
- The bathroom should look spotless. Also, don't forget to store toilet paper for your guest.

THE KITCHEN

Not all guests use the kitchen, but it should still get an excellent cleanup before any guest checks in.

- Make sure you vacuum every corner, especially under the shelves and cabinets, for dust and debris.
- Clean and put away the pots, toasters, burners, and other dishes from the countertops.
- Wipe the countertops, appliances, and switchboards. It should be spotless and free of any streaks.
- Review any maintenance issues and keep track of supplies that are running out.
- Every appliance should be clean, empty, and working.
- Do a thorough sweep and make sure the guest did not leave anything behind.
- Ensure that all consumables, such as milk, coffee, tea, and other such condiments, are restocked.

THE LIVING ROOM

Common spaces require less work than the other parts of your home. You should mainly inspect your property and remove left-behind items.

Sweep the floors well and ensure that the pillows and cushions for the sofas are well placed.

Check all the light bulbs and see if they're running correctly. Make sure to switch them out if they're not working.

Make sure the furniture has been polished and dusted. Bear in mind that you should also pay attention to the table and chair legs and the lower shelves and openings.
